- Ability to develop and implement treatment and recovery plans for individuals, groups, families and adults as required
- Well-developed oral and written communication skills, interpersonal skills and computer proficiency, including the ability to use client practice management systems.
- Capacity to work effectively both independently and as part of a multidisciplinary team,
- Demonstrate accountability and willingness to take direction and provide written reports
- A strong understanding of policies, procedures and regulations including mandatory reporting obligations
- Respecting and appreciating the cultural diversity of CALD and Indigenous families and their communities
- Maintaining a working knowledge of and adhering to legislation guidelines, policies
